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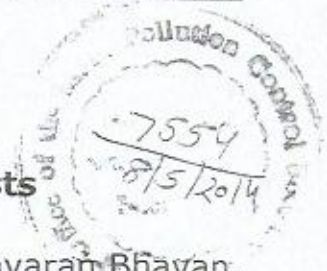

Sir,

The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its Order dated 17.04.2014 (*copy enclosed*) in the matter of disposal of 350 tonnes of toxic waste lying in the premises of the erstwhile Union Carbide India Ltd. (UCIL) in Bhopal has directed that a incineration of 10 tonnes of the waste should be carried out in Common Hazardous Waste Incinerator at Pithampur, District Dhar, Madhya Pradesh.

2. The Hon'ble Court has also directed that the entire process viz. packaging, transportation and disposal be videographed and be monitored by the experts of the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Madhya Pradesh State Pollution Control Board (MPSPCB) and the State Government of Madhya Pradesh.
