
Please refer to your petition dated 17/03/2015 addressed to the Hon'ble Prime Minister on the subject mentioned above.

2. Regarding criminal prosecution of responsible parties, the position is indicated below:-

The Chief Judicial Magistrate (CJM), Bhopal vide his order dated 07/06/2010 on criminal case No. 8460/1996 held all the accused persons guilty under Section 304A, 336, 337, 338 and 35 of IPC and awarded sentence of two years and fine for different amount to all accused persons, except Mr. Warren Anderson, Union Carbide Corporation, USA who did not appear before the trial court. Against the said order, Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) filed Criminal Appeal No. 487/2010 in the Court of District and Sessions Judge, Bhopal for enhancement of sentence. CBI also filed a

Revision Petition in the Court of District and Session Judge against the order dated 07/06/2010 of CJM, Bhopal, praying the Appellate Court to reframe the charges under Section 304 Part-II of IPC against the accused persons. The said Revision Petition was not admitted and hence the same was challenged in the High Court of Madhya Pradesh. As reported by CBI, Chief Judicial Magistrate has issued notice/summon to the Dow Chemicals Company, USA to produce Union Carbide Corporation, USA. All the cases are pending before the Hon'ble Courts.
